Bellevue Loves Memphis Workday | April 26, 2025

Through Bellevue Loves Memphis Workdays, volunteers come alongside local partners to serve local churches and schools, refugees, widows, and our closest neighbors. Projects may include light construction, painting and landscaping, and hosting sports camps or block parties. Help us love Memphis like Jesus does!

Mission Memphis | July 20-26, 2025

Be part of our annual week-long mission trip to Memphis! All ages and stages from our church will come together to serve our city. Projects occur at various times and locations throughout the week and may include light construction, Vacation Bible Schools, sports camps, and more. Join us as we invest in the renewal of our city!

Jesus Loves Memphis Workday | October 25, 2025

On this day, churches from all across Memphis will come together to serve our city. Multiple service projects will be available, from sharing the Gospel and serving food to light construction and landscaping. There are ways for people of all ages to be the hands and feet of Jesus to our neighbors!

Bellevue Christmas Store | December 2025

The Bellevue Christmas Store serves families in need who have children age 12 or younger. At the Christmas Store, parents and legal guardians can purchase gifts for their children at 75 percent off the retail value. There are a variety of ways you can serve with this ministry and share Jesus with our neighbors.

Mid-South Mission of Mercy | January 2026

Mid-South Mission of Mercy is a free, two-day dental clinic for underserved and underinsured people living in Memphis and the surrounding areas. We need 2,000 volunteers to serve with this ministry!

City Engagement Team* | Eight Weeks | Summer 2025

Use your summer to reach our city with the Gospel! During the summer, students across Memphis are out of school, which creates opportunities for us to intentionally care for them and their families. Join a team and work alongside our local ministry partners to engage our most vulnerable neighbors.

MID TERM OR LONG TERM (SERVE OUT PATHWAYS)

Legacy Thrift Center

Bellevue's thrift center supports missions efforts and distributes Bibles around the world. When you serve with Legacy Thrift, you help provide scholarships for mid-term missions opportunities and Bibles to those who don't have one.

Christian Mobile Dental Clinic

The Christian Mobile Dental Clinic serves patients in underserved areas of our community. You can volunteer as a driver, a dentist, a dental assistant, or an evangelist. Through this ministry we meet a physical need in the hopes of ultimately meeting our neighbors' greatest spiritual need.

Prison Ministry

Bellevue visits several local prisons each week, and we need volunteers to complete our ministry teams. Both men and women are needed to help share the Gospel with and disciple inmates.

Dexter K-8 School

Dexter K-8 School is located only one mile away from Bellevue. Over the past few years our church has built a great relationship with Dexter students and faculty. Help us invest in our neighbors by being a reading coach or assisting with after-school Bible Club.

Rock Creek Apartments

Rock Creek Apartments are only a mile away from Bellevue's campus and are home to a diverse community. Many of the residents are far from God but open to conversations about the Gospel. There is currently a ministry team living in Rock Creek Apartments with the purpose of making disciples. Through this Pathway, Bellevue Missions works alongside the onsite ministry team to reach Rock Creek residents with the Gospel.

One by One Ministries

One by One provides trained church-based mentors to serve and walk alongside vulnerable, at-risk, new, and expecting families who visit faith-based pregnancy care centers. Through this Pathway you have the opportunity to be a mentor and come alongside moms in need.

Binghampton Christian Academy

Binghampton Christian Academy is a Christian boarding school and day school dedicated to developing both spiritual and academic excellence in their students. Through this Pathway you can connect with and pray for students as they walk through a formative school year.

World Relief and Refugee Memphis

You have the opportunity to serve families who have undergone unimaginable circumstances—people who have left their homes and everything familiar to them due to threatening conditions and sought refuge in our country. Through this Pathway you can come alongside refugee families and support them as they adjust to their new lives in Memphis.

WRAP Ministry

Bellevue's WRAP Ministry provides support for foster parents and families through Words of affirmation, Respite care, Acts of service, and Prayer. Through this Pathway you can care for a foster family in one of these areas with a team of others who are dedicated to serving families.

Sista2Sista

Sista2Sista is a ministry in the Binghampton community that provides housing, meals, rest, and healthy relationships for women struggling to break free from prostitution and addiction. Serve alongside this ministry in a practical way by providing meals for women at Sista2Sista's drop-in center.
