### I. Put Aside - I Peter 2:1

Malice – "active intent to harm others" 1 Corinthians 14:20

Deceit – "wicked, full of deception" 2 Timothy 3:13

Hypocrisy – "showy, empty display of religion, worldly, legalistic" Matthew 23:5-7

Envy – "resentment against another's success, jealousy" Galatians 5:19-21

Slander – "evil speaking, that which is morally injurious"

Matthew 15:18

#### II. Long For – I Peter 2:2-3

Pure milk of the Word – God created a mother's body to provide nutrition for her newborn baby. This is the only food an infant needs and provides everything the baby's body requires to grow and stay healthy. Breast milk provides immunity boosting antibodies and healthy enzymes just as the Word of God provides immunity against the flesh and awakens us to spiritual life and maturity.

## III. Build Up - I Peter 2:4-8

Cornerstone – "The cornerstone was always the first stone laid during construction, and every other stone in the building was measured by the standard of the cornerstone to ensure a proper fit. In calling Jesus the cornerstone, Paul explains that those who want to form the stones in the household of God must be conformed to the image of Christ. In other words, we must be disciples who are daily becoming more like the Savior. Of course, perfect conformity to Christ's image is impossible before we are glorified (1 John 1:8–9); nevertheless, all of those who are in Jesus will have a basic desire to turn from sin and follow Him in a life of obedient discipleship." #### IV. Chosen – I Peter 2:9-12

"But you are a **chosen** race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;" (1 Peter 2:9).

"Each of these pictures emphasizes the importance of unity and harmony. We belong to one family of God and share the same divine nature. We are living stones in one building and priests serving in one temple. We are citizens of the same heavenly homeland. It is Jesus Christ who is the source and center of this unity. If we center our attention and affection on Him, we will walk and work together; if we focus on ourselves, we will only cause division" (*The Bible Exposition Commentary* by Warren Wiersbe, p. 403).
