



Course Title: Algebra 2 w/Trigonometry

Description:

This course, designed for students who have completed Algebra 1, will provide one high school math credit. Topics covered will include quadratic equations, polynomials, complex numbers, logarithms and trigonometry. Students will learn to solve algebraic functions and graph them. Upon completion of this course, students will be prepared to advance to precalculus.

Algebra 2 w/Trigonometry will prepare your student to continue in their math studies in Precalculus or higher. The course is designed for the student that desires a deeper level of math study. Trigonometry will be introduced in the second semester to prepare the student for higher math.

Recommended Grades: 10+

Prerequisites: Successful completion of Algebra 1 or equivalent with 85%+ full-year grade
