



Course Title: High School Art

Description:

Ready to take your love of art to the next level? The High School Art course will build on concepts from Middle School Art while teaching at a level that welcomes students participating in their first art class. The high school art course will dive deeper in similar subjects to our middle school art but at a higher grade level with high school expectations. A wide variety of art materials will be emphasized, as well as artists and their techniques. The fundamentals of a strong work of art will be examined in the context of discussions about the *elements of art/design* and the *principles of art/design*. The elements we will study are: line, shape, form, texture, space, color, and value. The principles we will study are: balance (symmetrical/asymmetrical), proportion, unity, harmony, variety, emphasis, rhythm, and movement.

Students will explore the following areas of the study and practice.
